## Vocabulary Words:

**Roots**: part of the plant that's typically underground; it provide water and nutrients to the plant and also keeps it in the ground

Stem: the main structure that keeps the plant upright and holds the leaves

Leaves: the part of the plant that absorbs the sun's energy and coverts it into food for the

plant

Photosynthesis: the process in which plants use sunlight to make their food

Flower: part of the plant that blossoms and makes seeds

Nectar: a sweet liquid produced by plants

Pollen: a fine powder produced by plants to help them reproduce

Pollinators: insects like bees and butterflies that help spread pollen from flower to flower
