A MESSAGE FROM OUR LEADERS

"If people are going to have a meaningful relationship with nature, it's going to be, for the most part, in cities. That means it's either the end of meaningful nature, or the beginning of a new kind of city." -Richard Louv, Last Child in the Woods

For the past two decades, the Urban Ecology Center has been engaged in building this new kind of city. From an innovative approach to environmental education to community festivals that engage neighborhoods across all constituencies, the Center is a proven model for transforming communities by revitalizing urban green space. In the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the culmination of many donors, volunteers, and organizations working together have helped us expand this important work to serve more kids and families. This year we experienced a tremendous amount of growth, with accomplishments visible at each of our Center's branches.

Our branch in Menomonee Valley celebrated its one-year anniversary since opening its doors in September 2012, creating a new gem for our southside community. More than 1,000 Milwaukee-area residents came together to celebrate the opening of Three Bridges Park in the Menomonee Valley in July, which now includes a one-mile extension of the Hank Aaron State Trail, hiking and walking paths, and even a canoe launch, so the community can once again be connected to nature.

The opening of the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum is another milestone that has occurred in our amazing two decade effort to preserve and protect the urban lands along the restored Milwaukee River corridor. In total the Arboretum, which opened in September 2013 at Riverside Park, boasts over 2,200 new trees within its 40-acre area of urban nature, further increasing awareness and appreciation of the biological diversity found in this area.

A quieter but equally exciting achievement this past year was that we added a fruit orchard at Washington Park! The orchard not only provides educational and research opportunities, but it is also a vibrant space where the community can reap the fruits of the land and have access to fresh produce. Washington Park staff and volunteers were hard at work planting roughly 50 fruit trees and over 1,500 native plants to establish the orchard.

Over the past year, the Center continued to connect and inspire more people in science through ground-breaking research. Our Research and Citizen Science program serves as a meaningful bridge between academic research and the community at large, where volunteers of all ages conduct cutting-edge research and have the opportunity to present their research at conferences across the country. The Center had many exciting developments on a national level as it led the country as an advisor to the first-ever Citizen Science conference in Portland, Oregon, was one of 30 organizations selected (out of 300) to steer the launch of the Citizen Science Association, and presented research at the International Congress for Conservation Biology in Baltimore, Maryland.

Due to all of your generous and deep support for this important work, we have created beautiful spaces that improve the richness of our urban habitats and help people connect to nature. Is our community connecting? We think so! Our research team **created a park-use study** indicating that people visited the natural areas of our three branches over 208,000 times this past year. Add program participation and visits to our three buildings for a grand total of over 307,000 visits this year alone! It is because of your unwavering support through your time spent volunteering, your talent devoted to our community, and your investment in our programs and mission that have continued to make a difference in the Milwaukee community, connecting kids and adults to nature.

MISSION HIGHLIGHTS

In the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the Urban Ecology Center continued to connect 100,000 program participants and even more park visitors with the outdoors in an effort to help them live healthy, abundant lifestyles. Whether providing environmental education to urban youth or protecting public natural land, we help connect people to place and experience. Our mission has far-reaching impacts, spreading beyond the neighborhoods we directly serve. Through projects like the opening of the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum and Three Bridges Park, we are able to build effective partnerships and catalyze meaningful change in our community.

Provide Environmental Education to Urban Youth

We provide the opportunity for youth to explore the natural world right in their own neighborhoods to help build curiosity, understanding and respect for nature. Over the past year, our educational programs have engaged more children and adults in outdoor science than in the past. Our Neighborhood Environmental Education Project (NEEP) partnered with a total of 48 Milwaukee schools, including eight new schools that partnered with our newest branch in the Menomonee Valley that opened in September 2012. A total of 25,714 students and 3,557 adults explored urban wilderness, engaged in experiential science education and gained ecological intelligence! Over 4,000 participants in this school program recently completed ecological literacy surveys; 93% of these students indicated they felt more connected to nature, had developed their critical thinking skills, gained a deeper sense of community and strengthened their respect for the environment – all because of their experiences with us. NEEP is complemented by our summer camps, and this year 625 campers in 53 camps were connected to urban nature through hands-on, inquiry-based activities every day of these week-long camps!

The Young Scientists Club (YSC), our after-school program that engages kids ages 5-13 in building leadership and presentation skills, continues to flourish, particularly at our Washington Park branch. This past year, the YSC designed and conducted an original research project on birds in partnership with the University of Minnesota's Driven to Discover program, entered their findings into a national citizen science database called eBird, created a poster summarizing their project and presented at three different national conferences! The involvement from this dedicated group of kids continues to inspire, as they develop an environmental ethic and a sense of civic responsibility that can help drive positive change in our community.

Protect Urban Nature

Our three branches made tremendous strides in working to make public areas safe, accessible and vibrant. It was a historic year with the opening of two new greenspaces in Milwaukee - Three Bridges Park in the Menomonee Valley and the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum in Riverside Park. These important areas of urban nature are protected for generations to come. Both include accessible trails to the rivers, providing universal access to nature.

At the end of our year we had the opportunity to protect a critical 4.5 acre piece of land located in the middle of the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum, once owned by the late Pieter Godfrey. Situated with the Oak Leaf Trail on the east, Riverside Park to the north, and the Milwaukee River wildlife corridor to the south and west, this land is in the heart of greenspace that the Center has been protecting since the organization was founded in 1991. Thanks to the incredible and quiet support of 28 donors who understood this once in a lifetime opportunity, the Center now owns these 4.5 acres. The future vision will need to fully emerge over time, but we are grateful and excited to protect and make vibrant this important land.

Promote Community

We continually strive to offer resources that enhance learning, support volunteer experiences and promote camaraderie. Year













after year, we are humbled by the support of the individuals and groups that come together to engage with us. This year has been no different. Across our three branches, we had a total of over 3,192 individuals volunteer and contribute over 20,000 volunteer hours at the Center. Whether beautifying our buildings, introducing urban youth to the Milwaukee River for the first time, or helping conduct invaluable park research, volunteers keep the Center buzzing with activity all year long and continually have a positive impact on our community. We are so appreciative of our volunteers for their tremendous investment of time and talent to support this important work!

We also continued to foster relationships within our community. Through local food programs, public festivals, and eco travel opportunities, the Center's community programs engaged individuals of all ages and backgrounds in recreational and learning activities that help them understand and appreciate the environment.

Preserve Land and Water

Our land stewardship team managed over 80 acres of urban land this year with the continuous help of our very active and engaged volunteers, who contributed over 8,300 hands-on hours healing the land at all three of our branches!

The opening of Three Bridges Park in July 2013 was a huge milestone in transforming the landscape along the Menomonee River. This brownfield-turned-greenspace will serve as an outdoor classroom for our Menomonee Valley branch. Our stewardship team, in conjunction with many project partners, have worked hard toward restoring the 24 acres of park space. Native Wisconsin species typical of prairie, oak-savannah, and oak-hickory woodland and wetland areas have been planted in the newly transformed soil that was formerly a degraded and abandoned site covered by an influx of invasive species.

In Washington Park, land stewards and volunteers doubled the size of the prairie and planted over 135 trees and shrubs in the future woodland. When we began the land stewardship efforts in Washington Park in 2007, we inherited seven acres of unmanaged, low-quality native habitat within the 124-acre park. The Center now stewards over 14 acres of prairie, woodland and wetlands that are in transition to high-quality ecosystems. These areas now include

a variety of native Wisconsin species, which improves the habitat for wildlife including species of special concern, threatened plants, amphibian, birds and mammals.

The opening of the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum in September 2013 is testament to the collaborative partnerships that lead to transformative change. The Arboretum project restored 5,280 feet of riparian corridor and 40 acres of forest, oak savannah and prairie, making it home to 70 species of native trees and hundreds of plant species. The land stewardship team planted over 18,000 plant plugs, 3,000 shrubs and 600 trees in the Arboretum this past year! The Arboretum is an urban ecological gem that has transformed post-industrial land into natural habitat and an outdoor classroom for experiential learning and growing.

Practice Environmental Responsibility

We continually focus on practicing and modeling environmentally responsible behaviors as a part of every decision we make and it is embedded in everything we do. To help us focus on systems thinking we invited Jaimie Cloud, of the nationally renowned Cloud Institute for Sustainability Education, to host a 2-day workshop for all staff at the Center. This workshop provided invaluable systems thinking tools related to the intersection of ecology, equity and economy, inspiring our staff to further our efforts in developing a sustainable future.

With the help from students and professors at the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee School of Architecture and Urban Planning, the Center monitors systems to gather and collect data on energy and water usage and savings. For example, from this data collection, we know now that our Riverside Park branch's photovoltaic system, which is a sustainable energy source that uses solar panels to generate electrical power by converting solar radiation into direct current electricity, produced 1/3 of the electricity that the building consumed, and we earned enough from our production to cover 43% of our energy costs within this past year! Collecting and analyzing this data will help us learn and think critically about what we do and will help further inform future decisions related to sustainability.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The 2012 – 13 fiscal year proved to be another successful year at The Urban Ecology Center!

This year, our goals included growing member and program services with the opening of our third branch in the Menomonee Valley, carrying out the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum capital project and continuing to enhance the infrastructure to support the organization's mission. To meet these goals, the Center increased the operating budget by 31%. We are pleased to report that the Center was able to meet and exceed these goals! The solid financial position in the following reports is a reflection of generous community support and dedication of staff members who carry out the Center's mission.

While reporting successful results in the current year, the Center has also been well-positioned for continued stability and growth in years to come. The Center's executive leadership, along with guidance from the Board and Committees, maintained a keen focus on the adequacy of cash and overall reserve levels, the positive ratio of assets to liabilities, and a robust fundraising pipeline to ensure a solid financial foundation from which to cultivate future growth. New contributions to our endowment this year continue to build towards a very bright financial future.

We have provided two financial statements to give the most accurate picture of our organization. Our Audited Statements include capital projects such as the Milwaukee Rotary Centennial Arboretum, whereas our Operating Statement of Activities shows the day-to-day costs of performing our core mission. Our operating revenue was \$3.3 million, while our total organization revenue was \$6.7 million for the 2012-13 fiscal year.





We have been working to improve the assets and accessibility of Riverside Park since our founders formed a grassroots group in the early 1990s. The Park Access Project was an outgrowth of our plans to serve more students from the Riverside Park branch. In 2008, the Milwaukee Rotary Club selected our proposal to create an arboretum to celebrate their centennial anniversary in 2013.
