Why Your Support of Science Outdoors Matters

Q. What is carrying capacity?

You are likely sleuthing through your middle school memory bank, checking the long forgotten file titled "ecology" to find the answer. What if instead of recalling memorized information, you recalled a game? What if in 7th grade you remembered pretending to be a deer while your friends acted as resources - water, food, shelter? Or

maybe in this game, you played the villain in the deer's storydeforestation, disease, or predator. You'd have a visual (and fun) representation of carrying capacity.

A. Carrying capacity is the maximum population size of a species that can be sustained by a specific environment.

For Notre Dame Middle School's 7th grade students, this particular environmental lesson happened this fall at the Urban Ecology Center (UEC). Kasandra Mentkowski, teacher and UEC field trip chaperone, recalled this day's impact on her students:

"As a middle school teacher for the last 5 years, I've seen how social media impacts kids - they want to look a certain way,

act a certain way. Kids are growing up so much faster. When

we go to the UEC, I get to see children be carefree

and fun. The minute students are outside of that traditional school setting, they leave the pressure cooker that school can be and let loose. The creativity and play I saw that day was such a needed boost for everyone. Play is emphasized with younger kids but I believe older kids need it just as much..."

Because of your support, the UEC's Neighborhood Environment Education Project (NEEP) is able to provide educational experiences like this and others to Milwaukee students. Kasandra recounted another NEEP field trip: "We did a

watershed program at McKinley Beach. I'd say 40% of the students in my class had never been to Lake Michigan before. The NEEP program brings kids who live in Milwaukee and takes them to some of the beautiful gems we

have here in the city. These natural spaces are a part of the city that, unfortunately, a lot of kids don't get to experience."

Your support gives teachers the ability to offer these experiential lessons to students. Kasandra shared that lack of transportation is a big issue for schools, "There are great opportunities in the city but we can't get there...by providing busing, the UEC removes that barrier."

Kasandra also knows the obstacles for students don't stop there. "Many students come from neighborhoods where their parents don't want them outside for safety concerns. So, it is a necessity to know they are going somewhere where they trust the people who work there and are comfortable letting their guard down. After one visit, they know the UEC is a safe place.

The relationship the kids develop with the parks and with the building is so important."

Kasandra's favorite thing about NEEP? "These trips spark student curiosity. One thing I don't get enough of as a teacher is questions. When I am on UEC field trips, the amount of questions they ask and their engagement is tenfold."

Environmental curiosity is something Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and the whole world benefits from. The carrying capacity of curiosity, play and exploration at the UEC? Limitless...because of you.

13,410 native plants were planted and protected in the three parks and public greenspaces in the 75 acres of land the UEC manages.


Number of wildlife surveys: 256



The Urban Ecology Center's Research and Community Science Program serves as a meaningful bridge between academic research and the community-at-large. This past year, 256 wildlife surveys were conducted to monitor the health of birds, bees, bats and other important species.







Over 350,000 species of beetles are assigned to the Order Coleoptera, which is the largest order of insects. Beetles represent a fifth of all living organisms. They are crucial to a healthy ecosystem as pest controllers, decomposers, nitrogen recyclers, pollinators and more! Big thanks to Heidi Meier for her work with these incredible little creatures!

Building on a Strong Foundation

Our Washington Park location was opened in 2007 to serve more neighborhood schools with our acclaimed Neighborhood Environmental Education Project. Located at the former site of the Milwaukee Zoo, we opened a site here to help with neighborhood revitalization efforts.

Turning Dreams into Designs

In 2021, we launched the Imagine Campaign to raise funds to reimagine our Washington Park location - to bring the wonder of nature to the heart of this vibrant neighborhood.

First, we listened. Through intentional conversations, we listened to our neighbors, to students, to community leaders, to supporters, to the County and to the City.

Together we committed to:

- Building a new education and community center
- Beautification efforts on the 20 acres surrounding the building
- Partnering with Milwaukee County Parks to upgrade infrastructure

With the help of some incredibly creative and sustainablyminded people, we are wrapping up the design development phase of the new building. Key features include:

- A half-story slide in the lobby area
- A nature-themed art installation in the living area
- Several education spaces
- Flexible basement and functional workspace.

FISCAL YEAR 2021 - 22 FINANCIAL REPORT

The Urban Ecology Center celebrated So Much Life coming back to 3 locations as in-person attendance increased through activities and programs. Moving towards more regular functioning, budgeting and planning practices normalized. In fiscal year 2021-22, through disciplined spending and strong backing from our dedicated community of donors, the UEC closed the year with a near balanced budget even with a delay in receiving approved COVID-19 related government funding. The Urban Ecology Center embarked on the Imagine Capital Campaign and focused on meeting the goals for this 4 part comprehensive campaign as detailed on page 6. The 990 and audit present the combined balance of Operating and Capital Campaign funds in the 2021-22 fiscal year.

The UEC remains committed to ensuring long-term fiscal sustainability, focusing on both immediate fiscal needs and future strategic planning. The UEC has carried no long-term debt to date - in part by only entering into agreements supported by existing pledges and donor contributions. The Board of Directors and Finance Committee maintain an intense focus on the adequacy of cash and oversight for all material financial aspects of the organization. The UEC has a positive ratio of assets to liabilities and a broad donor base, ensuring a solid financial foundation for future growth. Its annual financial statements are audited by the Milwaukee-based accountants of Scribner Cohen & Co.




