- Use of our Audio/Visual Equipment You are welcome to use our in-house sound speaker system, portable PA, projectors, and microphones. Urban Ecology Center staff will gladly set up and take down any equipment and give you and your guests a tutorial on the use of the equipment.
- Wireless Internet Connectivity We offer use of our wireless network throughout the building and to all guests.
- Use of our kitchenette & appliances. Guests are welcome to utilize our kitchenette during the duration of their event. This includes commercial appliances, a variety of small kitchen electrics, and a variety of serving utensils and place settings.
- Use of our furniture. Our staff is happy to set up Urban Ecology Center furniture for you and your guests. We offer tables and chairs to accommodate seating for 80 people, or up to 100 seated lecture-style
- **Onsite Rental Staff** 2 rental staff members will be present throughout the duration of your event to answer any last minute questions and assist with facility-related details.

Room Descriptions

Whole Building*

Maximum Occupancy: 100 for seated meal, 150 for social gathering

Perfect for weddings and parties, rental of the whole building gives you the flexibility to spread out and host your event in the best way you see fit. You get exclusive access to our 1st and 2nd Floor open areas including the green patio and animal room, both of our classrooms, the living room, Valley Room and kitchenette.

Whole building rentals are available Fridays and Saturdays 5pm-12am or any 7 hour window on Sundays.

Valley Room

Maximum Occupancy: 50 for seated meal, 80 for social gathering

Large antique barn doors can seal the Valley Room from the rest of the first floor, making this a suitable venue for meetings, seminars, workshops, or luncheons during the day or for smaller parties or lectures in the evenings. It is a spacious and relaxed meeting hall with large windows overlooking the gardens and Hank Aaron State Trail below. After hours rentals can keep the barn doors open and have access to the Living Room as well.

Classrooms: Flowerpot Classroom & Patio Room

Maximum Occupancy: 18–20 per classroom

Our Flowerpot Classroom on the 2nd floor is a beautifully lit room with a high ceiling, original wood floors, and a charming terra cotta color that gives the room its name. This room is perfect for a work retreat or business meeting for up to 20 people.

Our Patio Classroom sits on the lower level next to our outdoor patio on the Hank Aaron State Trail. French doors can open to expand the space and let in fresh air in the summer. This room is perfect for meetings and project groups of up to 18 people.

Conference Room

Maximum Occupancy: 10

This small private meeting space on the 1st floor is perfect for your next off site business meeting or planning session. This room features a central conference table with 10 chairs and plenty of natural light.
